PROGRAMMING COORDINATOR (YEAR-ROUND)

The FOLD Foundation hosts the annual Festival of Literary Diversity – Canada’s first festival for diverse authors and storytellers, located in Brampton, Ontario. The Planning Team for the FOLD is comprised of volunteers who are committed to bringing diverse stories to the Brampton-based festival each year and promoting and cultivating diverse voices year-round.

The Programming Coordinator is responsible for logistics and execution at the festival and will take a key role in programming and executing events during the off-season.

THE ROLE

- This volunteer role reports directly to the Artistic Director
- Responsible for programming off-season events (Major Author events, Write Now)
- Attend festival and off-season events, coordinating authors and volunteer support
- Booking off-season venues, communicating with authors, liaising with program partners
- Manage survey results from festival and off-season events
- Reading diversely year-round to contribute to on-going programming discussions

THE REQUIREMENTS

- Attending monthly planning meetings in Brampton
- Ability to work with minimal supervision
- Passion for books
- Experience with writing/publishing considered an asset
- Familiarity with Brampton is a benefit, but not an asset
- Lived experience with disability, race, culture, gender identity, Indigenous voices, seniors, and other marginalized communities is considered an asset
